In an emergency, make sure your family and home are safe, then check-in on the Kent County Primary Emergency Repeater 146.970 (-) MHz, PL 77 for instructions. If no response on the repeater, use 146.970 simplex (77 HZ tone). Prepare by registering with the Emergency Coordinator, N3KRX, and by coming to the Kent County

ARES/RACES meetings the last Monday of the month.

GUIDELINES FOR EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS:

- 1. Check-in on the above frequencies** if you suspect an event is taking place. Assume automatic net activation if your phone has no dial tone. Non-Ham frequencies to monitor are:
Emergency Alert System (EAS) Radio WNCL-930 AM WRDX-92.9 FM WDSO-94.7 FM WAFL-97.7 FM
National Weather Service: 162.500 MHz / Sudlersville 162.550 MHz / Lewes 162.475 MHz / Salisbury
- 2. Listen to the Net Control Station** and direct all communications through him/her.
- 3. Listen more than you talk.** Strive for brevity and clarity – Plain Language and ITU Phonetics. No Q-Signals or 10-Codes .
- 4. Formal messages MUST be written: Radiogram or ICS-213 form signed by an Emergency Official.**
- 5. Keep an Event Log.**
